Attention all Cub Masters,

It is time to register your unit's Pinewood Derby winners for the District level race and Best of Show Competition. Attached you will find a copy of the 2012 District Race registration form. A copy of the K-Valley District rules can be obtained at the K-Valley District website at www.kv-scouts.org or by contacting Chris Bernier at circleofone555@hotmail.com

Please complete the registration form and send payment made out to Pine Tree Council prior to the April 7th Deadline. The registration fee is \$5.00 per scout. Each Pack may send its top three race winners and 1st place Best of Show winner. In the event that one of your top three race winners or your best of show winner can not attend the district derby one alternate may be selected in both categories by the pack to race or participate in best of show in replacement of the absent scout. Please see the district rules for more specific rules concerning this.

Check in will begin at 8:30 a.m. and judging for Best of Show will begin at 10:00 a.m. The Derby Race will begin at 10:15 a.m. Each racer will race one time on each of the four lanes. The times will be calculated by computer to determine the placing of each car entered in the race. Trophies will be awarded to the Scouts with the five fastest race times. Trophies will also be given to the five cars that are awarded Best of Show.

This year's race will be held at the Jay Community Center which is part of the Jay Middle School.

Directions can be found at the end of this registration form. Please note that you should download and use the latest District Rules Revision for your race and for the district race guidelines. The latest version as of January 13th is Rev 1.5

The fourth place winner will race in that person's place. Each pack may also send the 1st place winner of their Best of Show and 1 alternate. Units who preregister (Names and payment received by deadline) will be able to go through the express check in line at the Race. Units who do not preregister and send payment prior to the event will have to check in through the Late registration line.

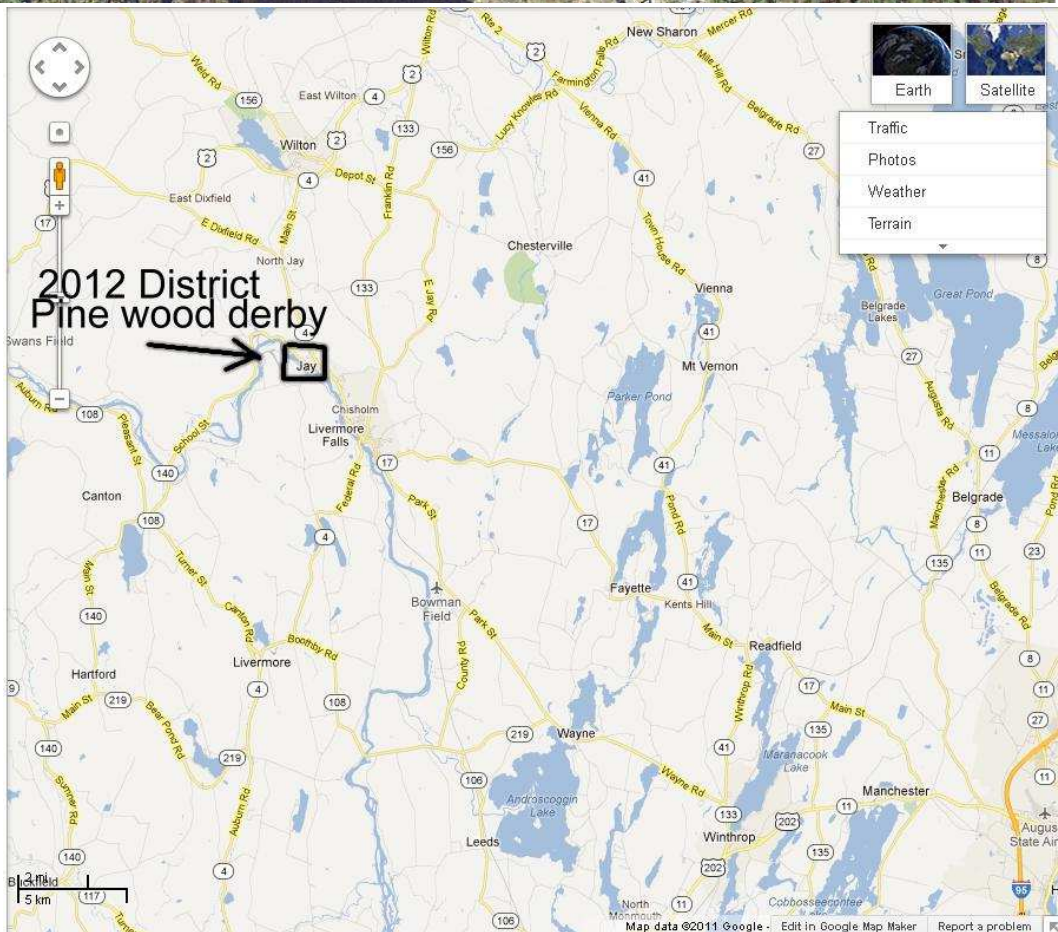

DIRECTIONS TO THE 2012 DISTRICT PINWOOD DERBY.

From Farmington:

Follow State Route 4 south (US Route 2 west) to Wilton. Turn left and continue to follow Route 4 to Jay. From the intersection of US Rt. 2 to Community Dr. is 14.7 miles. Community Dr. is on the left. Plan on 25 minutes to reach Jay.

From Augusta:

Follow State Route 17 to Livermore Falls. Rt. 17 makes a sharp right with the "Chuck Wagon" Restaurant on the corner. Continue following 17 for 1.7 miles. Community Dr. is on the right. If you reach the intersection with State Route 140, you missed the turn by about a mile. Plan on an hour to reach Jay.

From Skowhegan:

Follow US Route 2 west to Farmington Falls, turn left onto Route 156. After crossing bridge, 156 takes a sharp right. Follow 156 to Wilton. Turn left onto US Route 2 west/Route 4 south. Turn left on US Route 4 South to Jay. From the intersection of US Rt. 2 to Community Dr. is 14.7 miles. Community Dr. is on the left. Plan on an hour to reach Jay.

From Pittsfield:

Follow US Route 2 west to Skowhegan and follow Skowhegan route. Add 25 minutes to the time.

From Waterville:

Take your choice: Drive Route 27 to Farmington Falls, and then follow the Skowhegan directions, OR drive south to Augusta and follow the Augusta directions. Plan on about 75 minutes on either route.
